3 OF THE MANY REASONS GOD SAYS 'NO'

CAUTION: Use these to comfort yourself, but NEVER use them with someone in pain, because you don't know why God said no to them.

GOD SAYS 'NO' WHEN

1. HE HAS _

No creature is hidden from him, but all things are naked and exposed to the eyes of him to whom we must give an account. Hebrews 4:13

(God) so that he may guard the paths of justice and protect the way of his faithful followers. Proverbs. 2:8

2. HE HAS _

God: "For my thoughts are not your thoughts, and your ways are not my ways." This is the LORD's declaration. "For as heaven is higher than earth, so my ways are higher than your ways, and my thoughts than your thoughts. Isaiah 55:8-9

3. HE HAS_
